

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY, U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS,  
PORTLAND DISTRICT  
AND  
THE PORT OF LONGVIEW, WASHINGTON  
REGARDING THEIR 2017 AGREEMENT PERTAINING TO OPERATION AND  
MAINTENANCE OF DREDGED MATERIAL DISPOSAL FACILITIES  
FOR  
THE COLUMBIA RIVER PORTION OF THE COLUMBIA AND LOWER WILLAMETTE  
RIVERS FEDERAL NAVIGATION CHANNEL, OREGON AND WASHINGTON**

1. This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is entered into by the Department of the Army, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Portland District (the Government) and the Port of Longview, Washington (the Port) for the express and limited purpose set forth herein.
2. The purpose of this MOA is to revive, for the period prescribed below, the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by the Government and the Port, along with other parties, in 2017 (the 2017 Agreement), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
3. The Government and the Port acknowledge that the 2017 Agreement expired, according to its terms, in 2020, but wish, for reasons that are good and sufficient for each, to revive that agreement for a short time.
4. The Government and the Port express their willingness to resume their respective obligations under the 2017 Agreement, as incorporated herein, and each affirms that it possesses sufficient legal authority to do so.
5. This MOA takes effect on the first business day after the date as of which both parties have signed, below, and it shall terminate one year after that date.
