**A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Longview memorializing individuals who have lost their lives in industrial accidents at marine terminals within the Port of Longview District.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Longview wish to memorialize individuals who have lost their lives in industrial accidents at marine terminals within the Port District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Port of Longview District encompasses multiple marine terminals with shared workforces along the Columbia River; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Longview recognizes the inherent dangers of work performed at marine terminals; and

**WHEREAS**, a memorial has been constructed in front of the Port's Administration Office which includes a ship anchor and chain mounted in concrete, surrounded by a circular raised flowerbed with benches; and

**WHEREAS**, the names of the individuals who lose their lives in industrial accidents while working at marine terminals within the Port District will be affixed to the memorial; and

**WHEREAS**, the memorial provides a physical space for family, friends and the community to honor individuals who have lost their lives in industrial accidents at marine terminals;


