

**PORT OF LONGVIEW COMMISSION  
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-14**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF LONGVIEW DESIGNATING A PORT OF LONGVIEW AGENT FOR ACCEPTING ANY CLAIM OF DAMAGES MADE UNDER THE REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON, AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2001-22.**

**WHEREAS**, The Port of Longview is a special purpose district established under the laws of the State of Washington; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 4.96.020 requires that "The governing body of each local government entity shall appoint an agent to receive any claim for damages under this chapter;" and

**WHEREAS**, Jaime Thayer, Manager of Finance and Accounting serves as the Port Auditor for the Port of Longview, as established in Resolution No. 2018-3;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Longview that the Port of Longview Auditor, Jaime Thayer, is now hereby designated as the Port of Longview's Claim Agent and as such is authorized to receive, on behalf of the Port of Longview, any claim for damages made under the Revised Code of Washington.

This designation shall be recorded with the Cowlitz County Auditor's Office in accordance with RCW 4.96.020.
