**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF
LONGVIEW, WASHINGTON DECLARING THE PLYMOUTH LOCOMOTIVE
SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING ITS SALE AND/OR
DISPOSAL**

WHEREAS, the Port of Longview has in its possession an inoperable locomotive, which could have a value of greater than \$10,000; and

WHEREAS, due to usage, age and inoperability, this equipment is no longer suited for operational purposes; and

WHEREAS, such property having been certified in writing as not needed for Port purposes by Port Staff, a copy of said certification is marked Exhibit A and attached to this Resolution; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Longview, pursuant to RCW 53.08.090 that the said property be declared surplus, and that the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) is authorized to sell or dispose of the property in the best manner which the CEO, in their discretion, shall determine, including a competitive third-party auction bidding process or direct disposal in the event the property cannot be sold.
