RESOLUTION 2023-07**

A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF LONGVIEW'S BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 1993-14 RELATED TO REPORTING IMPROPER GOVERNMENTAL ACTION AND PROTECTING EMPLOYEES FROM RETALIATION, AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2001-20 RELATED TO THE POLICY FOR A DRUG AND ALCOHOL-FREE WORKPLACE.

WHEREAS, on October 15, 1993, the Port of Longview Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 1993-14 establishing Port policy for reporting improper governmental action and establishing a policy for protecting employees against retaliation under the "Whistleblower Act," chapter 42.41 RCW.


WHEREAS, on August 14, 2001, the Port of Longview Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2001-20 establishing a drug and alcohol-free workplace at the Port.

WHEREAS, since the Port Commission adopted these two resolutions, the Port has created an employee handbook, and the Port now desires to amend the employee handbook addressing and updating the topics covered in the above-described resolutions, rendering the resolutions obsolete and unnecessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Longview rescind in their entirety Resolution No. 1993-14 and Resolution No. 2001-20.

ADOPTED by the Port of Longview Board of Commissioners this 23rd day of August, 2023.


